Welcome to Fosse Bank



How we spend the money we raise

The FA Committee is responsible for deciding how the funds are spent. Usually the School Leadership Team provides a 'wish list' of items that the school would like us to consider funding.

We invite input from parents too, so if you have an idea for something which would benefit our pupils, please share it with the Committee. We can discuss it at a meeting and feed back to you.

Funds are typically spent on the 'extras' that are not provided by the school's budget, thus making our children's learning experiences so much more fulfilling and exciting. Funds are not generally spent on improving the fabric of the school building as this is the responsibility of the school. Recent items the FA has bought for the school include:

- STEM blocks
- A huge, portable, interactive screen
- The playground canopy
- Additional sports equipment
- Games tables and play equipment for the playground
