Dear Parents

Information was sent out earlier today regarding the three positive cases of Covid at Fosse. We are hoping to get through the last two weeks of term with minimal disruption. As mentioned in the Parentmail, any children in Years 5 or 6 who are not in school but are well enough, will be able to attend Zoom lessons as well as independent learning. Information regarding these will be sent from the class teacher.

Upcoming events are still going ahead as planned, the first of which is the Fosse Association Christmas Fair this Sunday at 1pm-4pm. On Tuesday 30th children in Years 5 and 6 will be signing at the Hildenborough Farmers' Market. Please ensure your child arrives at school promptly **no later than 8.45am** to enable for registration before leaving for the market. KS1 have been busy practising their nativity and this will be shown to parents on Wednesday 1st December at 9.30am. The performance will be in the sports hall and seating will be socially distanced. Masks can be worn and are optional at the moment. The Carol Service is at 6pm on Monday 6th December at St John's Church in Hildenborough. Again, we hope this will take place but please understand that there may be late notice cancellation of events depending on the situation within school.
